## NON-REGULATORY CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

Governmental, municipal, or provincial agencies, or their designees, that do not have jurisdiction to administer environmental certification or licensing programs and would like to have WPI run their employees or military personnel through the WPI Certification or Professional Operator Certification programs. Non-regulatory certification program class membership holds the right to nominate, vote, and hold office.
